You will lead and maintain the Integrated Strategic Masterplan for M1/M2, ensuring that programme activities, asset reinvestments, maintenance and operations are coordinated within one integrated planning environment.

### Your responsibilities will include:

- Developing and maintaining the Integrated Strategic Masterplan, including dependencies, resource constraints, track possessions and key milestones.
- Coordinating planning across the 3xR Programme, asset-reinvestment projects, maintenance, operations and key stakeholders.
- Identifying schedule risks and opportunities through critical-path analysis, scenario planning and schedule assessments.
- Supporting programme governance and executive decision-making through planning analyses, reporting and strategic insights.
- Developing planning standards, governance, baseline management and planning methodologies.
- Develop what-if scenarios, facilitate planning workshops and providing planning analyses to support the decision process and support the programme management.
- Working closely with Metroselskabet colleagues and the programme's long-term consultancy partner.
- Provide strategic planning advice to the programme leadership team.

We imagine that you have solid experience from large and complex infrastructure programmes and enjoy working across organisational boundaries to create structure, transparency and informed decision-making.

- At least 10 years' experience working on large infrastructure, rail or other complex engineering programmes.

- Experience from rail, metro or other operationally critical infrastructure is an advantage.
